UNI Professor of Trumpet since 1986, **Randy Grabowski** is a dedicated educator and accomplished performer. As an active soloist and clinician, he has presented concerts throughout the United States, Canada, South America, and Europe. He has served as Principal Trumpet of the Waterloo-Cedar Falls and Cedar Rapids Symphony Orchestras, the Reno Philharmonic, and the show orchestras of Reno and Lake Tahoe. Besides performing with numerous television and radio artists, he has appeared with the Chestnut Brass Company and the Britt, Spoleto, Great Music West, and Bear Lake Music Festivals. Grabowski holds DM and BME degrees from Indiana University as well as an MM from the University of Nevada-Reno.
