UNI Suzuki School—Student Instrument Rental Agreement

Print 2: 1 for the SCHOOL and 1 for the FAMILY

All instruments and accessories are the property of the UNI Suzuki School and may be claimed by the Director or the Director's agent at any time. UNI Suzuki School owned instruments may be rented only by families enrolled in the program.

Rental fees are \$20 a month. Rental fees will be assessed as follows: If instrument is obtained after the 15th of the month, no rent for that month will be charged. If the instrument is returned before the 15th of the month, no rent for that month will be charged. Rental fees will be added to the family's Suzuki fees statement. When paying, rental fees can be included with instructional fees. There is no penalty for instruments which are traded in for next size. The rental agreement continues but a new rental agreement with the size and number must be submitted. Summer rent will be collected at the end of summer at the annual fall registration (\$60). Rental fees may be waived as part of a financial assistance package. NOTE: Families receiving financial assistance receive instruments rent free.

All responsibility for the care and protection of these instruments rests with the family to whom the instrument was issued until such time the instrument is returned in acceptable condition, to the person authorized to receive it. If an instrument is lost, stolen, or damaged in any way, the family to whom it was issued must assume full financial responsibility for replacement or repair. Any repairs done to the instrument, including selecting the repair technician, must be approved by the Director or Suzuki Coordinator in advance of the repairs. (Maintenance of the instrument such as re-hairing of the bow and other repairs due to normal wear and tear will be done by the program. The renter is responsible for replacing strings. If there are any questions, please contact the Director or Suzuki Coordinator.

If a family to whom a program owned instrument has been issued withdraws from the UNI Suzuki School program for any reason, this contract will be terminated and the instrument must be returned immediately. Instrument will be inspected by the teacher for usable strings and parts and any damage should be reported before any instrument is given to a student. The School is responsible for replacing any worn strings before the instrument is checked out. The student is responsible for replacing strings after obtaining the instrument.
