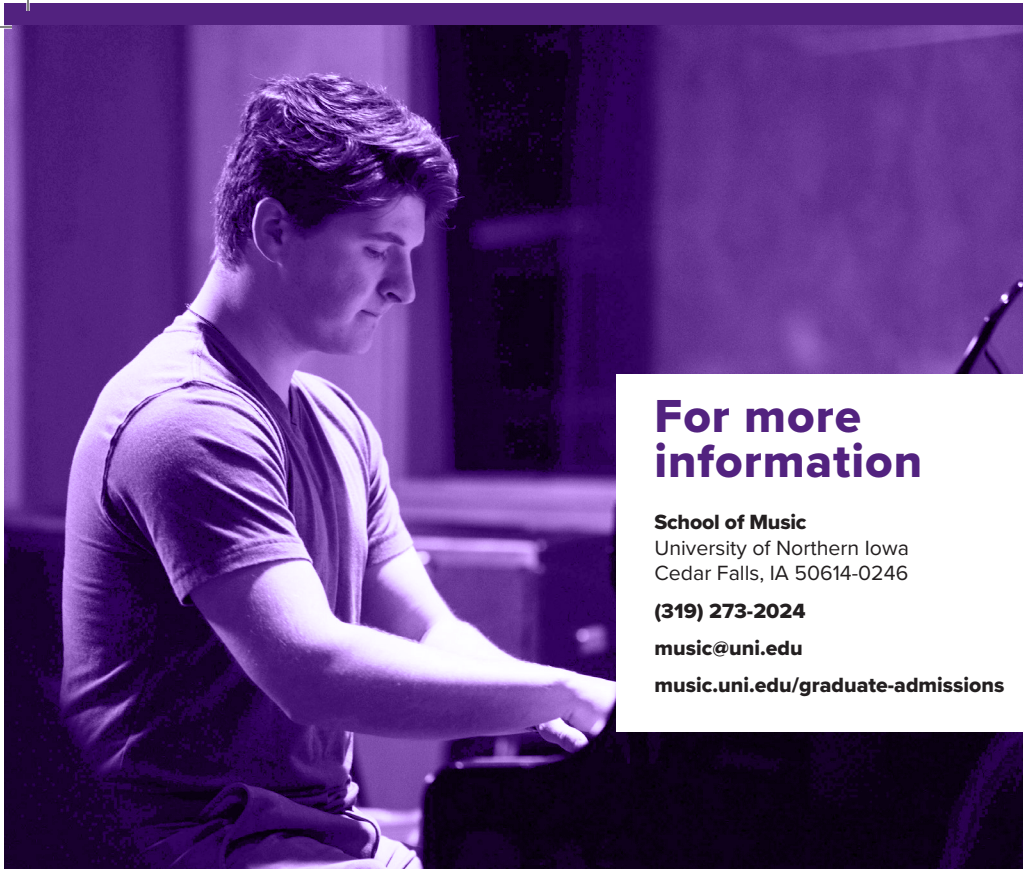
Awards

- Graduate Assistantships (GA) provide a salary of \$5,476-\$10,952 per academic year (current rates; subject to change for future years).
- All graduate assistants also qualify for automatic in-state tuition rate.
- Scholarships ranging from half to full tuition are also available. Students may apply for a GA, a scholarship, or both.

Admission Requirements:

- Bachelor's degree in music
- Successful audition/interview/portfolio
- Minimum 3.0 GPA
- Minimum TOEFL score of 79 (IBT) for international students
