About the Artist

Levi Temple is a Trombonist/Composer/Educator from Monticello, Iowa, currently in his final year at the University of Northern Iowa studying Music Education: Jazz/General. In his time at UNI, Levi participated in many ensembles including Jazz Band One, Northern Iowa Symphony Orchestra, Zorevo, Utter, No Promises, Symphonic Band, Panther Marching Band, Jazz Slides, UNI Trombone Quartet, and UNI Trombone Choir. Accomplishments as a Panther include being a finalist in the UNI Emerging Artist Competition, a semi-finalist in the UNI Concerto Competition, and a recipient of the Director's Award for the Panther Marching Band.

Accomplishments outside of UNI include the release of his debut album What Once Was, selection to the Telluride Jazz Festival Student All-Stars, admittance to the Skidmore Jazz Institute, and winning the Collegiate division of the Iowa Brass Young Artist Competition. Equally respected as a composer, he has had over a dozen compositions and arrangements premiered, including a commissioned score of music for the UNI Theatre Department's production of "The Tempest." Following graduation, Levi plans to pursue a Band Director position in Iowa while continuing his career as a performer/composer.
