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The **Iowa City West High Jazz Ensemble** is one of three full size jazz ensembles offered at West High School. 90 students participate in the jazz program at West. The West High Jazz Ensemble was selected to perform at the Iowa Bandmasters Convention in 2013 as the Honors Jazz Band. The band has qualified for the Iowa Jazz Championships every year for the last 22 years. During that time, the ensemble has finished in first or second place eight times. Every year, each band gets the opportunity to work and perform with nationally known jazz artists. This school year, our guest artist was tenor saxophonist and composer Chad Lefkowitz-Brown. Recent guest artists have included Donny McCaslin, drummer Matt Wilson, students and faculty from The Juilliard School in New York City including jazz pianist Frank Kimbrough, Terell Stafford, Jonathon Batiste, Joe Saylor, Bob Mintzer, Sean Jones, Mike Lee, Paul McKee, John Allred, Reggie Thomas and Mark Colby.

Rich Medd has taught instrumental music at Iowa City West High School since the 1995. Rich received his Bachelor of Music degree from The University of Iowa in 1987. He has served as a jazz band clinician and judge in Iowa and Illinois. He is past-president of the Iowa Unit of the International Association of Jazz Educators. He has also been on the staff of The University of Iowa Jazz Camp for the past several years, and has also taught at the University of Northern Iowa Jazz Combo camp. Rich performs as a trombonist throughout Iowa and Illinois. He is 21 year veteran of Orquesta de Jazz y Salsa Alto Maiz. He currently performs with The Rod Pierson Big Band, James Dreier's Ritmocano, and recently began performing in the Odd Bar Trio with University of Iowa Jazz faculty Steve Grismore and Jim Dreier. He also performs for shows, musicals, and for various touring companies. He has performed in groups backing up such artists as Carmen Bradford, Kevin Mahogany, Aretha Franklin, Carla Bley, Steve Swallow, Ray Charles, the musicals Ragtime, The Full Monty and My Fair Lady, The Mid-Town Men, The Moody Blues, The Temptations, Wayne Newton, Johnny Mathis, Natalie Cole and John Pizzarelli.
