GUEST CONDUCTORS

Mr. Thomas Bankert is in his 14th year as director of the Wakefield (MA) High School Band Program, as well as K-12 Director of Visual & Performing Arts in the Wakefield Public Schools. Mr. Bankert hails from Cape Cod, Massachusetts and received his bachelor's ('02) and master's ('03) degrees in music education from Syracuse University, where he was a two-year drum major of the Syracuse University Marching Band and Associate Conductor of the SU Symphonic Band. While in Wakefield, Mr. Bankert has led the marching band to six consecutive NESBA Finals Platinum Medals, as well as a nomination by Governor Deval Patrick to represent Massachusetts in the 2012 National Independence Day Parade in Washington D.C. Mr. Bankert has led the Wakefield High School Jazz Ensemble to nine Massachusetts State Gold Medals, and two 1st Place finishes at the Berklee High School Jazz Festival. Mr. Bankert has also led the Wakefield HS Wind Ensemble to five Massachusetts state gold medals. Mr. Bankert has been a clinician at the Massachusetts Music Educators State Conference and conducts the Northeast Massachusetts Honors Youth Wind Ensemble. Mr. Bankert lives with his wife Jackie, two wonderful children Avery and Finnegan and their mini bernedoodle named Milo.

Erin Holmes is in her 22nd year as a music educator. As Director of Bands at Farmington High School, Holmes is the conductor of Wind Ensemble, Jazz I, Director of the award winning Farmington Tiger Marching Band, Music Department Chair, and an active member of the Equity Leadership Team. Holmes recently was the Jazz Education Chair of the Minnesota Music Educators Association (MMEA), the first woman in the organization's history to hold this position. Holmes also appears in the December 2017 issue of School Band and Orchestra Magazine as one of the nation's "50 Directors Who Make a Difference." When asked what is your proudest moment as an educator? She responds, "My proudest moment as an educator has yet to come. Each day brings a new experience that challenges my mindset, intellect, and emotions on such a wide-ranging scale. Each year has also brought my own expertise to new levels. To try and define my pride of what we have created here in Farmington to one moment just isn't possible." Her favorite phrase she lives by and attempts to instill in her students is "every day is a good day to get better." Holmes is also active as a director for honor bands, clinician for band and jazz festivals, and adjudicator for large group contest, solo & ensemble contest, and teaches master classes for saxophones for jazz and classical saxophone in the metro and surrounding areas. Ms. Holmes loves to teach private lessons, has performed in several jazz ensembles such as Southern Minnesota's REAL Big Band, Swing Sisterhood Big Band, and the Caprice Saxophone Quartet. Holmes attended Minnesota State University, Mankato, graduating Magna Cum Laude in Music Education with a saxophone emphasis. Holmes also attended Saint Mary's University achieving her Master of Arts in Education. Erin and her husband, Jon, have three sons, William, Henry, and Duke, that keep them extra busy!

A regular conductor at the forefront of important professional symphonic bands and orchestras in Europe and America, Francisco Javier Gutiérrez Juan tackles all kinds of genres and makes recordings, television and film soundtracks. He is in possession of the titles: Superior Professor of Orchestra Conducting; Senior Professor of Composition; Senior Professor of Oboe; Professor of accompaniment, etc. He has starred in important historical recoveries of lost or altered works, and published the treatise "La Forma Marcha" edited by ABEC. He is currently the principal conductor of the Municipal Symphonic Band of Seville; conducts orchestras and symphonic bands and gives lectures and classes at universities in Spain, the United States, Portugal, Italy, Costa Rica, Slovenia, Argentina, Lithuania, Colombia, Poland and Venezuela; participates in international congresses; he is part of tribunals in international competitions; He is President of the Music Section of the Hon. Athenaeum of Seville; collaborates with all kinds of media. He has received numerous European and American awards and decorations. Among other formations, he has conducted the Royal Symphony Orchestra of Seville, the Symphony Orchestra of Castilla-León, the Cordoba Orchestra, the Malaga Symphony Orchestra, the Maracaibo Symphony Orchestra (Venezuela), the Italian Camerata Strumentale (Italy), the Trimitas State Orchestra (Lithuania), Andalusian Philharmonic Orchestra, Camerata Silva Dionisio – Purple (Portugal), Seville Philharmonic Orchestra, Harmonie Orchestra (Valencia), UPOL OK's Symphony Orchestra (Slovenia), RTVE Chamber Orchestra, Manuel Castillo Chamber Orchestra (Seville), Orchestra Classical of Granada, Symphonic Band of the Royal Guard of Spain, Berry College Symphony Wind Ensemble (USA), Rovereto Wind Orchestra (Italy), National Concert Band of San José (Costa Rica), Symphonic Band of the National Army of Colombia, Band MP Grisolía National Symphony (Argentina), Simón Bolívar Official Concert Band (Venezuela), Pacific Concert Band (Costa Rica), Guanacaste National Bands and Puntarenas (Costa Rica), Band of the Immemorial Regiment of the King N° 1, Music Band of the Soria Regiment N° 9, Music Unit of the Air Command of the Strait, Profesional Municipal Symphonic Bands of Madrid, Barcelona, La Coruña, Santiago de Compostela, Bilbao, Vitoria, Sta.
