The Northern Iowa Flute Choir was formed in 1986 by UNI Professor of Flute Angeleita Floyd for flutists to develop their ensemble skills, perform challenging repertoire, and to synthesize the music makina experience. The Flute Choir uses instrumentation spanning the sixoctave range of the flute family, featuring piccolo, "C" flute, alto flute in "G," bass flute and contra-bass flute. Under the direction of Dr. Floyd, the Flute Choir has performed for numerous functions within the School of Music, the University, and the surrounding Performances include the GBPAC Gala Grand community. 
