# About the Artist

In September of 2021, he and some peers founded the group, "Back Pocket", which performs both locally, as well as nationally.

Riley has performed in a number of places, including Northern Iowa, Iowa State, Upper Iowa University, Wartburg, Illinois, Charleston, Eastern Europe, and soon to be South Africa. He hopes to continue to add to this list, and continue to explore music across the country and world.

Riley is also very active in the recording industry, and has 20+ singles and a number of albums accredited to his name. In 2021-22 he spent his time studying at Catamount Recording Studios, as well as recording and mixing many local bands.
