ABOUT THE ARTISTS

The ever-exciting duo of trombone and tuba has found a new voice in **Sam & Dave's Brass Extravaganza**. This low brass duo has toured and taught extensively throughout the United States, and concluded their most recent season with performances and masterclasses in Germany. Sam & Dave's Brass Extravaganza focuses on pairing acoustic music with digital media – including computerized sounds, still images, and film.

The founding members of this unique ensemble are:

Dr. Sam Keehn - trombone, who serves as the Low Brass Professor at Augustana College in Rock Island, Illinois. She also performs with the Augustana College Faculty Brass Quintet and serves as the acting principal trombonist for the Muscatine Symphony Orchestra.

Dr. David Earll - tuba, who is the Assistant Professor of Tuba/Euphonium at Ithaca College in Ithaca, New York. He also performs with the Northern Lights Duo, The Ithaca Brass, and is the acting principal tubist with the Cayuga Chamber Orchestra.
