When paying, rental fees can be included with instructional fees. Checks should be made payable to UNI Suzuki. Those paying instructional fees using the 10 month installment plan can add \$19 per payment. Those paying fees with other payment options can pay their rent accordingly (2 payment plan-add 4 months of rent to each payment--\$76 each; 4 payment plan-add 2 months of rent to each payment--\$38 each). There is no penalty for instruments which are traded in for next size. The rental agreement continues but a new rental agreement with the size and number must be submitted. Summer rent will be collected at the end of summer at the annual fall registration (\$57). Rental fees may be waived as part of a financial assistance package.

All responsibility for the care and protection of these instruments rests with the family to whom the instrument was issued until such time the instrument is returned in acceptable condition, to the person authorized to receive it. If an instrument is lost, stolen, or damaged in any way, the family to whom it was issued must assume full financial responsibility for replacement or repair. Any repairs done to the instrument, including selecting the repair technician, must be approved by the Director or Suzuki Coordinator in advance of the repairs. (Maintenance of the instrument such as re-hairing of the bow and other repairs due to normal wear and tear will be done by the program. The renter is responsible for replacing strings.
